

Food Services Worker Part-Time

Principal Function:

To ensure that Siloam Mission efficiently fulfills its mandate to offer nutritional meals, in compliance with any and all applicable food preparation and serving regulations, as well as safety and cleanliness standards, as set by the City of Winnipeg Health Authority. You will report to the Food Services Supervisor. As part of Siloam Mission's mandate to be a connecting point between the compassionate and less fortunate, you will be expected to facilitate volunteers whenever possible in the performance of your duties.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assist with the preparation and organization of food that meets with Environmental Health and Safety guidelines
- Ensure that meals are ready to be served on time
- Work with volunteers in the overall operation of the kitchen and provide training, direction and supervision to kitchen volunteers
- To provide Christian leadership and support to volunteers
- Other duties as assigned by supervisor

Qualifications:

- Current Food Handlers Certificate (or willing to obtain)
- Desire to work in a large-scale kitchen environment
- Excellent interpersonal skills and the ability to form relationships with marginalized individuals
- Ability to effectively and efficiently direct volunteers
- Creative ability to prepare meals with variable ingredients
