



Individual Volunteer Opportunities at Siloam Mission

Food Services

Help out in the Kitchen with meal preparation, serving, and cleanup. Interact in a positive way with community members as they enjoy their meal. You will be serving via a window through the kitchen area into the Drop In center in an assembly style line up with other kitchen volunteers. Minors 13 years old and up can also fill out a volunteer application form, attend orientation and volunteer with a chaperone.

Drop In Centre

This is an opportunity to connect with those who are using our services. We are looking for volunteers who are willing to sit down, have a conversation and a cup of coffee with someone and be a good listener while taking the time to help out as needed to serve and clean up after the meal. This role is less task driven and more geared towards individuals ready to build meaningful relationships and provide resources to our community. Be a part of the team that fulfills both physical and emotional hunger.

Donation Sorting

Sort through and organize clothing and personal items donated by the community. This is a vital step that allows us to provide people with good quality clothing through our Clothing Room program. Minors 6 years old and up can apply to volunteer by filling out a volunteer application form and volunteer with a chaperone.

Clothing Room

Assist patrons as they choose clothing and request hygiene products. Fresh clothing is a very real need and you can help provide for that need in a personal way.

Donor Care

Help out with general office duties during weekdays, such as data entry, phone calls, word processing, and mailings. Build relationships with our donors by adding a personal touch. This is a volunteer opportunity where you will be working as part of a team. Further screening and training are required.
