Statement of Faith

- 1. We believe in one God who is both perfect and loving and expressed in personal ways as Creator, Redeemer, and Spirit.
 - Creator: Author and Sustainer of all of creation.
 - Redeemer: Jesus Christ who became human born of a virgin, conceived by the Spirit, sinless in life and, in love suffered and died for our sins, and was resurrected on the third day.
 - Spirit: comforter and counsellor, sent from heaven to guide us to God, to convict us when we sin and equip us to live in accordance with God's purpose for our life.

2. We believe the Bible is divinely inspired and communicates God's saving message and is our reliable authority in all matters related to faith and Christian living

3. We believe that all people are created in the image and likeness of God and are therefore creations of worth, value and dignity and full of the promise and potential that is unique to each person. We believe that systemic to all humankind is an orientation towards failure to live out the law of love, resulting in acts of sin against God, brokenness, and injustice.

4. We believe that the love, grace, and forgiveness of God is a free gift, made possible by the provision Jesus Christ made through His death and resurrection. By turning from our own selfishness and trusting in Jesus Christ we are reconciled with God and are free to experience a new life of promise and potential for which we were created.

5. We believe that God cares about how we live out our life and faith in Jesus Christ and provides for us a pathway to continued transformation as we walk in obedience to the teaching of Scripture and the moral principles contained therein. We believe faithfulness will allow us to grow and change so that we more perfectly reflect Jesus Christ in all things.
